## **1 RULES**

---

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing – [Windsurfing Edition \(WCR\)](#).
- 1.2 The Class Rules of the participating classes.
- 1.3 If there is conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (SI's), the SI's will take precedence.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

## **2 ADVERTISING**

---

Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.

## **3 CLASSES AND DIVISIONS**

---

- 3.1 The participating **classes** and divisions shall be:
  - 3.1.1 **Techno 293** – Youth Boy and Girl; Junior Boy and Girl, Minim Boy and Girl
  - 3.1.2 **Techno 293 Plus** – Open
  - 3.1.3 **Raceboard** – Open, Women, Masters, Grandmasters, Veterans
- 3.2 **Age Divisions:**
  - 3.2.1 Minim is under 13 years of age on 31st December in the year of competition.
  - 3.2.2 Junior is under 15 years of age on 31st December in the year of competition.
  - 3.2.3 Youth is under 17 years of age on 31st December in the year of competition.
  - 3.2.4 A Master shall be a competitor aged 40 or older (born 1979 or earlier).
  - 3.2.5 A Grandmaster shall be a competitor aged 50 or older (born 1969 or earlier).
  - 3.2.6 A Veteran shall be a competitor aged 60 or older (born 1959 or earlier).
- 3.3 A minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a division.

## **4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

---

- 4.1 All entries shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 19-Eligibility Code.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a paid up member of the relevant international class association, or of the IWA. Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 4.3 Eligible competitors may enter by completing registration form at the event site. The following shall be presented upon registration:
  - Proof of age
  - [Parental Permission Form](#) - *for those under age of 18*
  - Czech competitors shall provide ČSJ licence for year 2020 and valid health check
- 4.4 Coaches and team support personnel may register for the event. The following shall be presented upon registration:
  - Boat Driving Licence (if applicable)
  - Evidence of valid third party insurance

---

**5 FEES**

---

- 5.1 The required entry fee for competitors: 700,- CZK
- 5.2 Entry fees shall be paid in cash at registration

---

**6 RACE FORMAT**

---

- 6.1 Each event in the Open Championship is “open entry” in the discipline *racing*, and may include any or all of the formats- *course racing*.
- 6.2 Men and women, boys and girls, may race together.
- 6.3 Classes shall have separate starts.
- 6.4 Classes shall race a maximum 4 races per day, in a maximum 8 race series

**7 SCHEDULE**

	1000	Opening Ceremony
	1100	First possible warning signal
Sun - 5 <sup>th</sup> July	1000	First possible start of racing
	1500	Last possible warning signal

- 7.2 The prize giving will take place as soon as possible after the last race is finished.

---

**8 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION**

---

- 8.1 Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.
- 8.2 Unless otherwise directed by the organizing authority, boards and equipment shall be stored, launched and retrieved from the designated area.

---

**9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

---

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Czech Windsurfing Association Representative at the event.

---

**10 COURSES**

---

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

---

**11 PROTEST COMMITTEE**

---

A Protest Committee will be appointed according to WCR 91(a).

---

**12 SCORING**

---

- 12.1 Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A, except the discard is as follows
- 12.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 12.3 When 4 to 7 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 12.4 When 8 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

---

**13 SUPPORT BOATS**

---

Support boats shall be registered at the race office. Limited charter may be available and may be applied for using the coach entry form.

---

**14 SAFETY**

---

Every competitor under age 18 and support boat crewmember shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the SI's.

---

**15 PRIZES**

---

Prizes will be awarded to the first three competitors of each properly constituted class/division.

---

**16 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES**

---

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion.

---

**17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

---

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. The organising authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

---

**18 INSURANCE**

---

Each participating board shall be insured with adequate, and valid, third party liability insurance. Competitors must have an insurance policy according to race regulations CSJ (min. 9 000 000 CZK – approximately 350 000 EUR).

---

**19 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

---

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
